Individuals will assist with case management, advocacy, and empowering the people we serve. This is an excellent opportunity for students seeking real-world experience in a grass-roots, non-profit organization. Interns will be trained in a variety of skills to support people who are experiencing homelessness, poverty, and hunger. Duties will include intake, data collection, ongoing support, and assisting people during times of personal challenge in their lives. Interns will speak by phone with individuals, families, and other social service organizations under the guidance of the Executive Director and Director of Community Engagement.

Required Skills: Must be able to communicate effectively with a range of constituents across the demographic, educational, and socio-economic spectrum. Must process confidential information discreetly. Should possess solid general office skills and professional attitude. Prior experience with needs assessment a plus.
